



## PERKINS ENGINE NUMBER LOCATION GUIDE


Over the years Perkins has produced hundreds of different engines and each can have many different variants. So how do you know the exact specification of your engine? All the information you need about your engine is included in the serial number on your engine plate, which you can use to find the parts to fit on your engine.

The engine serial number is on a metal plate attached to the block, typically found on the lefthand side of the engine. The position of the engine plate varies across different engine series. You can find the position of your plate using the table below.






















The engine serial number is made up of:

- 1) PJ \_\_\_\_\_ is the engine family, in this case 1106D-E66TA
- 2) **12345**\_\_\_\_\_ is the engine build type number or engine order reference
- 3) U \_\_\_\_\_\_ is the country of manufacture, in this case UK
- 4) **123456**\_\_\_\_\_is the unique engine number
- 5) **P**\_\_\_\_\_ is the year of manufacture
